Al Stohlman, Lou Roth, Joey Smith, Lad Haverty, Cliff Ketchem, Al Shelton, Christine Stanley, Ken Griffin, Robert "Tommy" Littleton, even "Mr. Craftool" Dick McGahen.

Also many others have been a big part of the guild including Al Stohlman Award Recipients, Robert Beard and Roz Koahn.

The public is invited free to view member's displays and demonstrations of the Leathercraft artistry at our monthly meetings.

The LEATHERCRAFT GUILD meets the third Sunday of each month at 1:00 p.m.. Both at the Garvey Center 9108 Garvey Ave., Rosemead, CA. 91770 and rotate to Standing Bears Trading Post 7624 Tampa Ave., Reseda, CA 91335. The programs are highlighted by exhibits and demonstration of the latest in the field of Leathercraft, design techniques and tools. Some years a LEATHERAMA is conducted where members may compete for prize ribbons in several categories. This is a show of beautiful leather work.

A monthly NEWSLETTER is mailed to each member giving information on meetings, shows and other items of interest, plus a new Carvin' Corner. Our guild is affiliated with the INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION OF LEATHER GUILDS. A show is held once a year from which leather artists all over the world compete. This is fun times as well as a chance to view all kinds of leather work and meet some of the master leather artists. Small workshops are held which you may attend for a fee. These are usually conducted by masters in leathercrafting.
